To obtain the population of **Christian Palestinians**, the columns of the different Christian confessions existing at that time in the area (Greeks, that is, Orthodox; Catholics; Protestants; Latins) have been added; Muslim Palestinians have their own column (the first) and the Jews of historic Palestine have their own (the fifth). **Equivalence of place names: (1)** Akka (Akko); Hayta (Haifa); Safat (Safed); Nasira (Nazareth); Tabarya (Tiberias)/ **(2)** Nablis (Nabulus); Benisaap (Tulkarm); Cemain (Aqraba); Cenin (Jenin)/ **(3)** Küdüş (Quds, Jerusalem); Yafa (Yafo); Gazze (Gaza); Halilurahman (Hebron) -see document with 1899 vs. present day maps-.
